Moët & Chandon

R 1000.00 p b

The colour is an elegant golden straw yellow with amber highlights. Its aromas are radiant, revealing bright yellow-fleshed fruits (apple, pear, yellow peach), honey, floral nuances (lime blossom) and elegant blond notes (brioche and fresh nuts). The palate is seductive, richly flavourful and smooth combining generosity and subtlety, fullness and vigour, followed by a delicately fresh crispiness (fruit with seeds), to reveal the magical balance of Champagne.

Moreson Solitaire

R 288.00 p b - R70.00 p g

Made from 100% Chardonnay - a small portion of which is wooded - Solitaire is bottle-fermented in the traditional manner and undergoes a 24 month maturation. Once completed, and her characteristic biscuity nose and shortcake palate have developed, Solitaire is ready for consumption (Franschoek Valley, 4* Platter)

Graham Beck Brut

R 298.00 p b - R75.00 p g

A good-value alternative to Champagne, made by a renowned sparkling wine producer. A Pinot Noir and Chardonnay blend with 15 - 18 months' bottle-ageing on lees, delivering yeasty, nutty, complex

aromas and a creamy, rich palate with fine mousse. Freshness, lemony citrus fruit, crisp acidity and a lingering finish.

Chenin Blanc

De Meyer

R 168.00 p b - R45.00 p g

An elegant wine, with the nose following well onto the palate. Showcasing melon, citrus and minerals. Well-balanced acidity and long clean finish completes this wine. (Stellenbosch, 3,5* Platter)

Pecan Stream

R 155.00 p b - R 42.00 p g

A brilliant yellow-green appearance with fresh and rich notes of apricot and peach pip. The Viognier component adding attractive nuances of white floral and was barrel fermented for 10 months. The palate is dry, with dense fruit flavours. A medium-full textured mouthfeel followed by finely balanced natural acidity on the finish. (Stellenbosch, 3,5* Platter)

Kloof Street

Millieux and Leew family wines

R 178.00 p b - R46.00 p g

Pale straw in colour, this wine has a nose of sun ripened pears and wet granite. The palate has a vibrant acidity balanced by a soft, round texture and some pithy character. The wine has a fresh, mineral finish.

Fresh, and crisp with honey melon and pineapple aromas and flavours. Perfect for lunches, picnics and sundowners.

Sauvignon Blanc

Pecan Stream

R 150.00 p b - R 40.00 p g

A Sauvignon Blanc representing the more tropical style. Shaped around fresh fruit aromas such as granadilla, pear and apple with hints of gooseberry. The palate expresses great purity in fruit, and well balanced with a medium soft acidity.

D'Aria

R 160.00 p b - R 44.00 p g

A fresh, tropical style of Sauvignon Blanc with hints of guava, melon, asparagus and gooseberry aromas and flavours. An accessible wine with good mouth feel and a lingering finish.

La Motte

R 180.00 p b - R 48.00 p g

Intense gooseberry followed by green apple, winter melon and lemon on the nose makes this wine very friendly and approachable. The natural acid is covered by the gentle, full and creamy palate. In spite of the low residual sugar there is a mellow sweetness on the palate.

Iona Sophie Te Blanche

R 195.00 p b - R 50.00 p g

A nickname given for those who can't pronounce Sauvignon Blanc, is the inspiration behind this loved wine, produced from grapes grown by dedicated farmers in Elgin and the Cape South Coast.

R 175.00 p b - R 48.00 p g

Characteristics of green pepper, asparagus and gooseberry, with underlying tones of pineapple and passion fruit, are sustained by a fresh and well-balanced palate with prodigious length.

White Blends

Buitenverwachting Buiten Blanc

R 145.00 p b - R 39.00 p g

This is a lovely full-bodied Sauvignon Blanc based blend exhibiting glorious tropical fruit flavours with a fresh minerality that are achieved due to the vineyards perfect position and its cooling sea breezes. The palate is light, yet fruity, with green melon and ripe gooseberry flavours merging with hints of tropical fruit and green peppers.

Springfield Miss Lucy

R 232.00 p b - R 65.00 p g

This unique blend of Sauvignon Blanc, Semillon and Pinot Gris bursts with citrus pamplemousse flavours and an ample mouth feel, yet remarkably moderate in alcohol.

FootHills The Partners White

R 150.00 p b - R 40.00 p g

A white Bordeaux blend perked up by the inclusion of Viognier. The essential freshness and drinkability of Sauvignon/Semillon is there, but with added aromatics and flavour which demand your attention. There's apple and pear at core, but also a slightly savoury element from lees contact, all brightened by Viognier's exotic perfume and tropical flavour.

Pinot Grigio

Terra Del Cappel

R 150.00 p b - R 40.00 p g

This classic Pinot Grigio is sourced from 4 different regions in the Western Cape, each contributing its own individual character when blended together. Groenekloof (36%) provides the fresh acidity and structure with beautiful citrus flavours; Elandskloof (26%) abounds in fresh apple and lively acid; Franschoek (26%) and Stellenbosch (12%) both contribute riper peach and melon flavours which adds body and depth to the wine.

Pink Wines

Boschendal Chardonnay Pinot Noir

R 200.00 p b - R 55.00 p g

Exceptional wine-making yields an incredibly sophisticated crisp, pale blush wine with outstanding finesse and elegance. Hints of strawberry preserve impart an intriguing aroma, characteristic hints of ripe red berries are also evident.

Quando

The wine is pale pink in colour. Red Berries and cassis on the nose follow through with a juicy fruitiness on the palate and elegant acidity.

R 190.00 p b - R 52.00 p g

Well-balanced wine with beautiful mineral notes and excellent oak integration. Apricot and orange peel aromas are followed by flavours of almond and marzipan.

Glen Carlou (Unwooded)

R 210.00 p b - R 57.00 p g

Vibrant and fresh with hints of tropical fruit, citrus and a soft creamy finish.

Foothills

The flavour spectrum includes peach and apricots, the oak portion showing as toasted almonds, becoming more savoury on the finish, an ideal match for rich dishes and sauces.

Shiraz

Kleine Zalze (Vineyard Selection)

R 240.00 p b - R68.00 p g

All the fruit for this wine is sourced from Kleine Zalze's own vineyards. With good winter rains and then a relatively moderate summer they had very good ripening conditions. The result was great fruit concentration with very supple and elegant tannin profile. Careful attention was paid to

the viticultural practices to ensure the correct balance in the vineyards and to ensure even ripening of the fruit.

D'Aria (Single Vineyard)

R 220.00 p b - R 58.00 p g

An interesting blend of fruit-driven Shiraz and a small percentage of Viognier. The spicy characteristics of Shiraz are complemented by the floral notes of Viognier.

Leeuwenkuil

R 120.00 p b - R 34.00 p g

Opulent, bright fruit. A beautifully elegant palate with round tannins, layered with clove spice, ripe cherries and violets.

Pinotage

Ernst Gouws

R 172.00 p b - R 45.00 p g

Ripe black and red berry flavours abound on this modern example of South Africa's very own grape – a cross between Pinot Noir and Cinsaut. Soft tannins and a weighty mid-palate leans toward smoky or game meat.

Villiera

R 210.00 p b - R 57.00 p g

A new style Pinotage with subtle oak spice, plums, vanilla and a slight smokiness on the nose. On the palate it is soft but well structured with good length.

Cabernet Sauvignon

Jordan

R 315.00 p b - R85.00 p g

Progressive techniques such as overhead fermenters, pump-overs and gravity flow allow for the extraction of fully developed flavours and soft ripe tannins without compensating the tension and elegance captured from the various cabernet slopes. Here especially, the climate plays a significant role to allow great fruit expression and classic essences of cedar, brambles and toasted tobacco.

Rustenberg

R 215.00 p b - R 60 p g

The wine shows typical Cabernet Sauvignon flavour and aroma profiles of dark berries and tobacco with a well-structured and lengthy palate.

The First Lady Cabernet Sauvignon has a rich ruby colour with a bouquet full of sweet black currants, red berries and a lovely herbal character, complemented by a chocolate oak and vanilla background. This is an easy-drinking wine with ripe, smooth tannins and good structure.

Merlot

R 210.00 p b - R 57.00 p g

A savoury masterpiece. A richly-satisfying mouthful of dark plums and stewed fruit, this Merlot is full of earthy flavours with dark chocolate hints, savoury dried meat and plenty of spicy highlights.

Thelema

R 285.00 p b - R 78.00 p g

A wonderfully balanced, juicy, up-front red with smoky fruit flavours, and surprisingly firm tannins.

R 145.00 p b - R 40.00 p g

This warm, rich ruby red wine shows great complexity on the nose. There is a mixture of dark red fruit, cigar box and mint aromas with well balanced wood. Sweet, spicy undertones give this wine great depth.

R 195.00 p b - R 60.00 p g

The aromas are perfumed, peppery, spicy, smokey and exhibit ripe red fruit notes. As always the palate texture of this style of wine is supple, smooth on the entry but with enough grip to end dry and refreshing. In the mouth the texture and fineness of fruit tannin and

drinkability of the wine is immediately evident.

Buitenverwachting Meifort

R 190.00 p b - R 58.00 p g

Full bodied and complex red blend.

Warm and inviting nose showing elegant plum, red cherry characters combined with spicy oak and tobacco characters.

R 195.00 p b - R 60.00 p g

The nose of this wine reflects how it was made. Raspberry (Merlot), a slight herbaceousness (Cabernet Franc) and English toffee (oak) are combined in a harmonious way. The palate is juicy and rich and leaves a lingering dry, fresh finish.

Our Nouveau Cellar offers the unique experience of BEER TASTING all our draught beers. Each beer has been well-described and defined so that you may savour each mouthful and identify the flavours | ascribed to each of the beers you have chosen.

The number in brackets behind each beer is the Beer Tasting Number. This number is also placed on the underside of your glass of beer. This enables you to identify which of our 22 draught beers on tap it is that you are enjoying.

This number also gives you the opportunity to 'blind taste' your beer. Challenge your palate and see if you can identify which beer it is that you are drinking before checking the number on the underside of your glass. Reading the descriptions of the beers will give you the guidelines you need to help you identify the flavours and the nuances of each differently crafted beer.

Forries Ale (1)

Our Pale Ale strikes a great balance between malt sweetness and hop bitterness, with a deep golden colour and distinctive taste. Cascade hops highlight the aromatic bouquet and spicy flavours of this classic Pale Ale.

Alcohol 5.4%

Jack Black's Brewer Lager (2)

This beer is inspired by the hand crafted beers of circa 1910. Brewed with a strong malt backbone and a crisp refreshing finish, this is a great tasting, distinctive beer for all occasions.

Alcohol 5%

CBC Pilsner (3)

Carefully selected hops imparts a strong, hoppy aroma with a nice bitter finish.

Alcohol 5.2%

CBC Amber Weiss Bier (4)

A German-style craft amber beer, fruity and aromatic – banana ester and a slight hint of clove is noticed in the finishing. Since our Amber Weiss is only slightly

hopped, no more than a light bitterness is noticeable in the finish.

Interesting fact:

In Germany, especially Bavaria, Weissbier is considered a typical breakfast beer. Weiss means white because of the old beer categories of either dark or lighter coloured beer.

Mitchell's Foresters Lager (5)

A light (both in colour & body), refreshing Pilsner-type beer, which is sweetish and light on the palate. A slightly aromatic beer which is lightly hopped and VERY invigorating on a hot day. Also a favourite with the ladies

Windhoek Draught (6)

Windhoek Draught is a smooth, mellow, well-rounded draught beer, with subtle mango tones. It is easy drinking, crisp and fresh - perfect for social drinking occasions.

Guinness (7)

Guinness is creamy and smooth with a taste of coffee, dark malts, and hints of dark chocolate. The black bodied and smooth creamy head finishes with a dry roasted bitterness.
